The 2018 ACMT Annual Scientific Meeting will be held at the Washington Marriott Georgetown in Washington DC on April 6-8, 2018. The event will elevate the field's discourse by featuring national and international authorities, whose topics include:

The day before the 2018 ACMT Annual Scientific Meeting, on April 5 2018, ACMT will host a Satellite Session on *Toxic Threats, Chemical Security & Counterfeit Pharmaceuticals*. The day will kick off with a discussion of counterfeit pharmaceuticals led by Brian Donnelly PhD, RPh (Director of the Americas Region, Global Security, Pfizer) who will present a counterfeit opioid case, highlighting the multiple steps in bringing raw ingredients from outside the U.S. onto the streets masquerading as a legitimate, diverted pharmaceutical. The second part of the symposium will focus on Chemical Security. The agenda will include an expert group of researchers, disaster response personnel, and educators who will provide insight into chemical terrorism and HazMat response. Topics include current perspectives on modeling of airborne releases, planning for large-scale chemical response, access to reliable information, and new and developing medical countermeasures and antidotes.

Combined, these two activities are expected to be approved for 21 AMA PRA Category 1 Credit.

Target Audience: ACMT's Annual Scientific Meeting (ASM) brings together medical toxicologists, medical toxicologists-in-training, clinical toxicologists, poison specialists, emergency physicians, researchers, forensic specialists, laboratory technicians, and other health care providers, public health officials and scientists who deal with poisoned patients or environmental health.

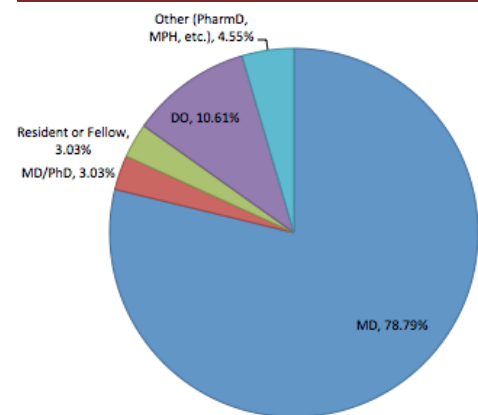
