After initial review, eight proposals will be selected for presentation during the MedTox Shark Tank at the 2019 ACMT Annual Scientific Meeting. Forum moderators will provide constructive comments and have \$\$\$ to invest in each presentation. Two presenters that garner the most investment money will each receive \$1,500 towards travel to the 2020 or 2021 Annual Scientific Meeting to present their research!

FIT Open Mic Competition

The FIT Open Mic Competition gives Fellows-in-Training the opportunity to give a lecture in a national forum where experienced speakers will offer insight on content and delivery. Any topic relevant to medical toxicology is appropriate—historical topics, mystery cases, molecular mechanisms, educational development, etc. Above all, we are looking for engaging speakers and interesting presentations. Proposals will be evaluated on content and originality.
