

Hello Dr. Dye,

Thank you for your message! When submitting an Addiction Medicine application through the Practice Pathway, we encourage applicants to be as descriptive as possible when detailing their Addiction Medicine-specific practice. This includes how many patients are treated/assessed per week, treatments and therapies offered, medications prescribed, etc. The Board will require additional information from those who provide brief and non-specific descriptions regarding Addiction Medicine practice activities.

There is also an "Additional Questions" section of the application where applicants have the opportunity to provide additional information should they choose. We encourage applicants to provide all required information in the appropriate sections of their applications, however, in the event that this information cannot be included in any of these sections, they may do so in the "Additional Questions" section of the application.
