



The Washington Poison Center is accepting applications for the **FULL TIME** position of Associate Medical Director. The ideal candidate would be self-motivated to provide continued development and clinical oversight of the WAPC Call Center's activities. The WAPC serves over 7 million persons in the State of Washington and is an unaffiliated 501^{(c)(3)} nonprofit corporation. The WAPC receives over 138,500 phone calls and manages over 67,500 cases annually.

The Associate Medical Director will work with the Medical Director to continue to develop clinical guidelines, a robust quality assurance program, assist our 3 MPH public educators, and provide clinically relevant teaching for both staff and providers.

This position is a full-time salaried position with a generous benefit package.

Candidates would require a Washington medical license, board certification or eligibility, and strong interpersonal skills. Poison center management experience is preferred.
