The Department of Emergency Medicine at UCSF Fresno in conjunction with Central California Faculty Medical Group is seeking additional core faculty members in Medical Toxicology. Our emergency medicine residency program was founded in 1974, with 44 EM residents in a PGY1-4 format and supported by UCSF and Community Regional Medical Center (CRMC) in Fresno, California.

CRMC has 630 beds with an average of 120,000 ED visits last year, while being amongst the busiest Level One Trauma Centers in California. Our ED sees the most critically ill patients in California, leading to a wide array of poisonings, overdoses and envenomations that we routinely consult on. Our inpatient Medical Toxicology consultation service provides 24/7/365 care for patients of all age groups with support from CRMC and the UCSF Fresno EM department. As well supervising residents on the inpatient toxicology service, we also participate in teaching toxicology to emergency medicine, internal medicine, pediatrics residents and critical care medicine fellows through lectures and SIM lab activities.

Our faculty group consists of 40 full time residency trained board certified emergency physicians. Applicants must be board certified in Emergency Medicine, board certified (or eligible) in Medical Toxicology, and must be able to obtain a California medical license at time of hire.

Residents and faculty enjoy a high standard, low cost living. Limitless recreational opportunities and spectacular scenery is all accessible in a community with abundant affordable housing. While there is much to see and do in Fresno, the city is ideally located for convenient getaways to the majestic Sierra (60 minutes away), as well as the scenic Central Coast, just two and one-half hours away. Fresno is the only major city in the country with proximity to three national parks: Sequoia, Kings Canyon and Yosemite.
