This 60-minute lecture allows ACMT members to inspire, educate, and contribute to the professional growth of future leaders in the field of medical toxicology.

Why Present?

As a physician and medical toxicologist, this is your chance to highlight your work, showcase innovative approaches, and foster meaningful education within the toxicology community. This platform provides a unique opportunity to engage with trainees while positioning yourself as a thought leader in the field. While past lectures have addressed early career planning, the Proposal Review Committee is especially interested this year in proposals that seek to broaden a fellow's perspective on the fundamentals of toxicology, unique historical aspects of the profession, or those that provide an in-depth review of the arc of managing a common toxicologic problem.

How to Apply

We invite ACMT members to submit a proposal to deliver this lecture at #NACCT2026. Proposals should include:

- Proposed Lecture Title
- Name of Presenter(s)
- Presentation Background
- Learner Objectives (minimum of 2)
- Presentation Method

Review Process

All submissions will be peer-reviewed by the ACMT Education Committee and leadership. Selected proposals will be forwarded to NACCT for final approval, with decisions anticipated by February 2026.
